Order Regarding Unsworn Statement in Place of Affidavit

The Judges of the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas, Domestic Relations Division make the following findings of fact:

1. Extraordinary conditions resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic have made it difficult, if not impossible, for many litigants to obtain properly notarized affidavits.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, until further order of this Court, any pleading or motion that is required or permitted by the Local Rules of this Court to be supported by affidavit or sworn declaration may, with like force and effect, be supported by a person's unsworn statement, in writing, signed and dated, as true under penalty of perjury, in substantially the following form:



"I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct."
